



Graduate Union Schedule of Policy to be Reviewed in Easter Term 2016

From prior to Academic Year 2010-11

The GU fileserver contains no minutes of Council meetings before this time.

It is suggested that – as policy is useless without knowing what it is – all policy before this year should be revoked.

From Academic Year 2010-11

- *To allocate £400 to supporting a GU Presence at the NUS National Demonstration “Funding Our Future: Stop Education Cuts” (adopted by the Council on 27 September 2010)*
- *To allocate £500 to a CUSU/GU campaign against international student visa reforms proposed by the government at the time (adopted by the Council on 2 February 2011)*

It is suggested that the above policies be revoked, as no longer applicable or relevant.

From Academic Year 2011-12

- *To hire a member of staff on a one year fixed-term contract (adopted by the Council on 7 September 2011)*
- *To hold a referendum on adopting a revised Constitution (adopted by the Council on 2 May 2012)*
- *To set the affiliation fees for 2012-13 (adopted by the Council on 2 May 2012)*

It is suggested that the above policies be revoked, as no longer applicable or relevant.

- *To create a code of practice for MPhil degrees, which should have a place alongside a potential undergraduate student charter (adopted by the Council on 30 November 2011)*

It is suggested that the above policy be revoked, as the idea of an MPhil code of practice is not well-enough defined by the minutes to carry forward with continuity of purpose.

- *To support the replacement of affiliation fees with a levy on colleges (adopted by the Council on 30 November 2011 and again on 2 May 2012)*

It is suggested that the Council should vote on whether or not to retain this policy.
